

MESSAGE TO RIDERS LANCASTER HISPANIC HERITAGE FESTIVAL

Due to the Lancaster Hispanic Heritage Festival event on **Saturday, October 5, 2024**, a number of detours will begin at 8:00 AM on Saturday morning continuing through approx. 7:00 PM Saturday evening.

The detours will begin at 8:00 AM when North Queen Street will be closed between Orange Street and Chestnut Street. All buses arriving at or departing at 8:00 AM or later will use the following detours:

Route 1/Southeast:

Departs from its regular stop at W. Chestnut & N. Queen. (at the County building). It travels the regular route but returns downtown via Prince to Vine to Mulberry to Chestnut to Queen and Queen Street Station.

Route 1/Park City A:

Regular route. No detour.

Route 2/6th Ward:

The downtown alternate stop will be at Chestnut & Duke Streets (NE corner). The bus travels the regular route but returns downtown via Duke to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut to Queen and Queen Street Station.

Route 2/Park City B:

Departs from the regular stop at Queen Street Station. The bus travels the regular route to and from Park City, but returns straight in on Chestnut directly to the temporary 6th Ward stop at Chestnut & Duke.

Route 3/8th Ward:

Departs from its regular stop at W. Chestnut & N. Queen Street (at the County building). Regular route through the 8th Ward, but the bus returns downtown via King to Mulberry to Chestnut to Queen & Queen Street Station.

Route 3/Park City C:

Regular route. No detour.

Route 5/Grandview:

Regular stop at Queen Street Station. Departs out the front of the station and travels Queen to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut and then regular route. Returning downtown, the bus travels Duke to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut to Queen & Queen Street Station.

Route 10/Lititz:

Departs from Queen Street Station. Bus travels the regular route. Returning downtown, the bus travels Duke to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut to Queen & Queen Street Station.

Route 11/Ephrata:

Departs from Queen Street Station. Bus travels regular route. Returns downtown via Duke to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut to Queen & Queen Street Station.

Route 12/New Holland:

Departs from its alternate stop at W. Chestnut & Queen Streets (by the County building). It travels regular route, but returns downtown via Walnut to Prince to Chestnut and the alternate stop on Chestnut at the County building.

Route 13/White Horse:

The downtown alternate stop is at Chestnut & Duke Streets. The bus travels regular route but returns downtown straight in on Walnut to Prince to Chestnut and the alternate stop at Chestnut & Duke Streets (NE corner).

Route 14/Rockvale Outlets:

Departs from the SW corner at E. Chestnut & Duke Streets (by the parking garage). Bus travels regular route and returns downtown via Orange to Lime to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut and the alternate stop at W. Chestnut & Duke Streets.

Route 15/Willow Street:

Departs from Queen Street Station and travels the regular route to Willow Street. The bus returns to Queen Street Station via Queen to Vine to Mulberry to Chestnut to Queen.

Route 16/Millersville:

Departs out the front of the station. Bus travels Queen to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut and then regular route. The bus returns to Queen Street Station via King to Mulberry to Chestnut to Queen & Queen Street Station.

Route 17/Columbia:

Departs out the front of the station. Bus travels Queen to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut and then regular route. Returning downtown, the bus travels King to Mulberry to Chestnut to Queen & Queen Street Station.

Route 18 - Elizabethtown:

Regular route. No detour.

Route 19 - Manheim:

Regular route. No detour.

Route 21 - Gap:

Departs from the temporary stop at E. Chestnut & Duke (SW corner). Bus travels regular route. Bus returns downtown via Orange to Lime to Walnut to Prince to Chestnut.
